Reminder of the Month: Over 18 Rule

No one under the age of 18 will have sole responsibility, not be alone with children. A youth may assist with children only when two certified adults are present.

Copies of Policy Key Points, Reporting Procedures, and Report Forms, as well as a list of approved volunteer workers, are in wall slots in halls and areas where children are cared for. Substitutes and “fill-in” workers with children must be on this list.
