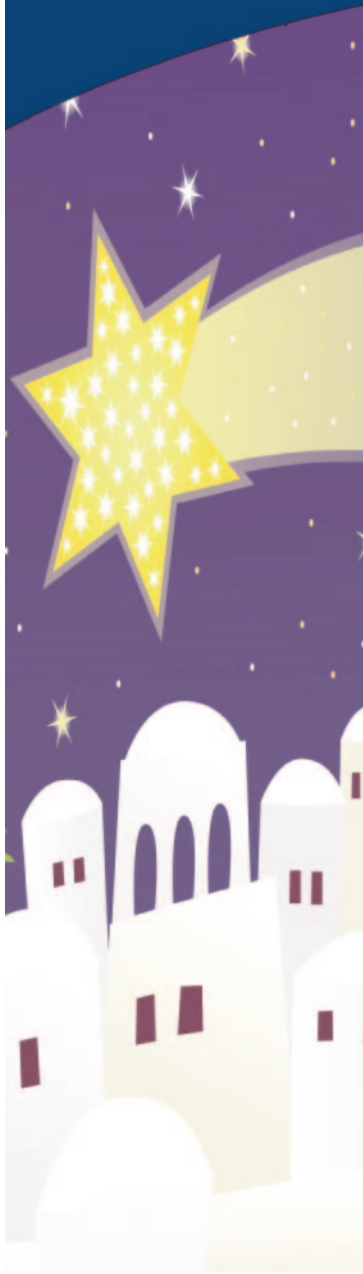
May we all know that our candles are not lit in vain. May we know the precious promise of the gospel ...

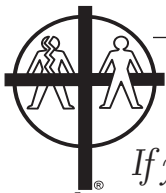
