I am not often without words, but the need to accurately compress the last five years of ministry into a succinct letter has left me unsure as to where to begin.

At the ripe age of twenty-four, fresh out of seminary y'all welcomed me into your church community with open arms. I have had the privilege and honor of journeying with you at the utmost joyous and wonderful celebrations. I was entrusted with the task of bringing a couple and family together through marriage. I was invited only hours after some of you welcomed new life into this world to hold and pray over your new love, and I looked your beautiful children in their eyes as I affirmed that through baptism they had been claimed and named by God. I have also shared challenging seasons and moments with some of you. From dreaded diagnoses to praying with your loved ones as they prepare to be accepted into the loving arms of our Creator, to celebrating loved ones' lives we have experienced these difficult events together. This church community showered me with kindness and grace as I learned through trial and error how to be your pastor, and I am still learning. I have not been the only one loving and serving in this congregation, far from it – many of you have showed me what it means to love one another in seasons of celebration and despair.

Two and a half years ago I announced to the congregation that I would be diving into the unknown sea of foster care. We celebrated together when Baby J entered into my life and y'all helped me put the pieces of my heart back together when he left. Regardless of what the future lays ahead for me in regards to my vocation, Shandon United Methodist Church will always be the first church I served and the place I found and developed my pastoral voice. But with all things, this chapter has come to a close and a new one will soon begin.

Now I will start a new learning process, as I begin a Clinical Pastoral Education residency at Roper St. Francis Hospital in Charleston. I will miss you and your loving families. I will miss the sweet hugs and excited greetings from our youngest disciples, but I know God is leading me towards a new direction and so I go with both anticipation and sorrow.

Soon you will have a new pastor to love and care for you and your families. On June 30th, Rev. Shannon Bullion will join the clergy staff as the Minister of Evangelism and Outreach. I know you will welcome her and her children Mackenzie (17) and Charlie (13) with hospitality and kindness just as you have with me, and I am hopeful about the many ways she will continue to shepherd this flock. I do not know what the future holds but I know God holds the future, and I believe God will continue to guide us all on the journey until we meet again.
